Seek harmony with Divine purpose. And begin to ask, “[Why] did the Source of my being guide or lead [me] into this particular action, activity, relationship and such? If the source of the attraction is found to be Divine Purpose or Creative Energy, the God Within Me, then I will have sufficient energy, light, happiness, to make this bloom and grow. But if that which is pulling me into this relationship — or even

caused me to think of it — is out of harmony with my highest purpose and that of all others involved, then the action, activity itself, will cause an energy drain and corresponding difficulties in the physical body and such.

Now think on these things and set new values by developing a regular relationship with that Force that is God. Visit with appreciation, closeness, [that] Life Force within yourself — twice or three times daily, visiting with that Force. Becoming still in a meditative mood, listening, for the highest within you will attract to the self in these times that you seek. Then seek the highest, the highest purpose, seek understanding of it. And building this, building calm and peace and acceptance, go forth to meet the day.

And how can you be sure, then, in this or that activity or relationship that I am not entering a wrong thing? How can you be sure of making no mistakes? If you would see God, if you would communicate with Him, see Him in those things that occur about you. See that as the result of His Presence. It is the result of the speaking of His mouth. It is not the Voice of God it is the result of His voice, that you see and hear through the senses of the flesh.

The Voice itself, then, comes through the proper use of the senses of the flesh. That is, in seeing, observing an answer to your question, so does the messenger providing that answer become clear in the consciousness. In this manner, one might train himself ever to hear, to know, to understand, until the Voice becomes clearer in spirit as the result of knowing it in the flesh.

One who cannot see wind can still know the direction thereof by seeing its effects in the trees or the grass.
