Japan

Question: Please describe disasters, climate changes, and catastrophes expected in Japan in the near future. What is the magnitude of the disaster? Can we prevent it? What are the safe places in Japan?

Answer: The question is not possible to answer exactly as you ask it. The magnitude of the disaster – if there is not a harmony with the earth, and the powers of the earth – is as great as the destruction of the entire land. On the other hand, the safe places are north and center, but more particularly one is safe at that place where he or she is doing the work that person is meant to do, – even if it is on the most dangerous line of the fault.

Be where you should be according to your guidance, doing the work that you should do to serve your Source, and you are safe. As to the forces which are building even now, there is earthquake activity and pressure building in Mt. Fuji, and there will be quakes and eruptions even between this time and 2001. The magnitude will be determined by the commitment of the people to honor the earth. Let every man, woman and child be committed to planting of trees, the reforestation. Concentrate not so much on these islands, but the reforestation of India.
