

Why Doesn't Jesus Talk of Reincarnation?

Question 3: Can you tell us why Jesus Christ never talked about reincarnation?

Answer 3: Now if you would understand those teachings that He brought, you would see that these were commonly accepted, and very calmly in His teaching dealt with. Not denied, neither a portion of the teaching, for was not necessary. That sought by the Christ on this plane to be taught is that ye are gods and sons of the Most High, as He quoted from the psalms. Respecting that passage, teaching, that the very nature of man, being that Son of God, is of that species of the Father God. And being God, then, if that that is God, or that nature of God be recognized within man, then should man be awakened to himself as God. Then no longer is flesh, nor corruptible, and would be lifted to see the Father, not incarnating again and again on this plane.

Then the very purpose of His teaching was that ye be lifted above reincarnation and not find it necessary to walk again in this plane. Then why should He so teach? For it was not the process of natural evolution that He was teaching, but rather the rising above, recognizing yourselves to be gods, more than animals. It should be animals that would reincarnate.
