## **Atlantis**

Q. The continental drift theory . . . that North and South America once had been joined to Europe and Africa in one great continent many years ago. Since the coastlines neatly fit together even today, there is no room for a continent of Atlantic in between. Please explain this inconsistency, for Atlantis is at the core of the reading.

A. The theory is not so far off as that as expected. Nothing particularly wrong with the understanding that these have been a portion of the same mass, does not make it [at] all inconsistent that there is below this plate or below these plates that have fit together, another, that as these drift apart, rises between them as occurs even at this time. Nor are the theories or the expressions, the memories of Atlantis, particularly at the core of these Readings, but the spirit of the Christ. These are attempts, then, to reawaken the memory of that spirit and cause an awareness of that as was developed at that time. Both, then, are quite true without any inconsistency.
