

A Closer walk With Jesus

This 8 CD series by Paul Solomon is a very special collection of private stories on the life of Jesus. The story is approached in three parts.

Part One: The Preparation, The Birth And The Life of Christ

CD 1 Paul begins this story with the Magi from the East who use their knowledge of the stars to guide them on their long journey to the birthplace of the Messiah. We see the Essenes and the Teacher of Righteousness as they prepare young women to be a potential mother of the Christ. The young woman Mary is selected by the Archangel Gabriel, impregnated by the Holy Spirit, and is married to Joseph. We see the political intrigue develop between Cleopatra of Egypt and Herod the Great in Israel. The stage is set for the birth of the Master.

CD 2 Herod the Great decrees that all children under the age of two years be put to death in a futile attempt to destroy the prophesied child who would be king. We follow Jesus and His parents to Heliopolis and meet Ishmael, the Essene gardener, who is sent to Egypt to grow Balsam herb gardens for Cleopatra. Jesus returns to Jerusalem where we find him teaching at the age of 12 at the temple on Solomon's Porch. The focus then moves to the ministry of Jesus. Jesus declares the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy. Peter, Andrew, James and John follow Him.

CD 3 Jesus turns water into wine at Cana. Judas and Matthew join Him. The story of St. Peter's fish and the silver coin. The master heals a blind man. Nathaniel and Philip follow Jesus.

CD 4 It is Holy Week in Jerusalem and everyone is preparing for Passover. Jesus brings His disciples together for the Last Supper. Judas betrays Jesus. The Master is arrested. Peter denies that he knows Jesus. the crucifixion and resurrection. Jesus appears before Mary in the garden. The Apostles gather in the Upper Room, are filled with the Holy Spirit, and go out to spread the "Good News" to all the World!

Part Two: The Life Of Christ According To Judas Iscariot

CDs 5 & 6 Paul "becomes" Judas to tell his own story. What was Judas thinking and feeling throughout the ministry of the Christ? What was his intention when he sealed Jesus' fate with a kiss? One of the most poignant portrayals ever of history's most infamous traitor.

Part Three: The Mystical Christ

CD 7 Paul takes a look at the esoteric story of the life of Christ as told by John the Beloved. Jesus lives his life as a drama so that His life and the way He lived became his teaching.

CD 8 Paul continues with the interpretation of the Gospel of John. Paul invokes the Presence of Christ to offer you an opportunity to Take A Closer Walk With Jesus.
